

I replaced my Krell Pre/Power with an integrated!!?!?

Netherlands distributor, [Transform Audio](#) brings news of a satisfied end user who recently traded in his Krell pre/power for the Perreaux 200iP

For the past few months I have been the proud owner of a Perreaux Reference series 200iP integrated amplifier. What a dream machine! The 200iP replaced a very large American Krell KSA 150 / Krell KRC-3 combination. It was a very big 150W class-A amp (45KG!!). On the face of it it was no easy job, but it succeeded handsomely. The reason why I chose the Perreaux 200iP was that this amplifier simply makes better music! The 200iP sounds as smooth as silk (not soft), open and very detailed in the mid range. The soundstage is excellent (not excessively big) and there's lots of depth. At high levels the instruments are so separated that each of them can be pointed out. Last but not least is the supply of power is sufficient to drive my big electrostatic loudspeakers.

Conclusion: The 200iP delivers an excellent sound for a "small" format amplifier! I'm very satisfied.
